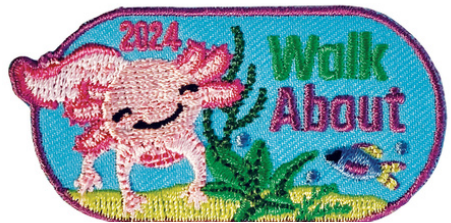
OWN YOUR magic

Girls are encouraged to decorate a wagon (or another mode of transportation), load up their cookies and hit the road to reintroduce one of Girl Scouts' longest traditions to the community.

Girls can participate individually or as a troop.

Walk-About Week is easy! From January 13-21 girls, along with a responsible adult, are invited to walk around their neighborhood and share some quality time while working on their cookie marketing skills. Girls can have their own "walking" booth sale. Girls should follow council, state and CDC guidelines when selling.

Please note: If you live in one of our mountainous service units and are faced with colder temperatures (or don't live in a neighborhood), girls can have a walk-about at a local indoor sporting or community event (must be mobile and cannot be stationary) or hold an "open house" and invite friends, families and neighbors to their home or private function.
